Here's what your child will be learning this half term:

Maths

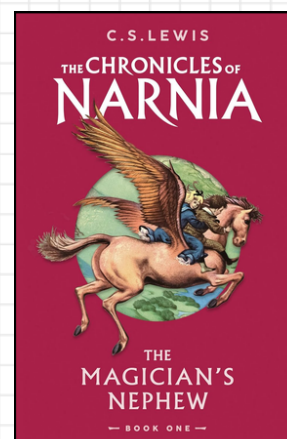
- We will learn about the properties of 2D and 3D shapes, including parallel, perpendicular, horizontal and vertical lines.
- We will practise drawing and identifying different shapes and lines.
- We will explore perimeter by measuring and calculating the total distance around shapes.

Writing

- We will learn how to use speech punctuation and inverted commas correctly.
- We will write poetry based on emotions and formal letters of complaint using clear structure and paragraphs.

Reading

- We will read and explore The Magician's Nephew.
- We will learn how themes develop across a text and how authors build meaning for the reader.
- We will develop skills in explaining and justifying ideas, using evidence clearly from the text.



Across the Curriculum

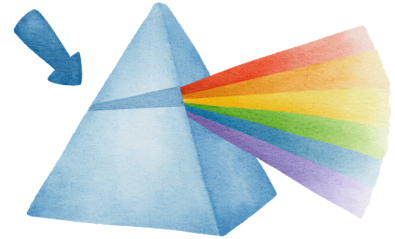
History - We will continue learning about the Romans and their impact on Britain.

Geography - We will revisit our learning about the United Kingdom.

Art - We will explore painting and printmaking using a range of techniques and materials.

Computing - We will explore events and actions in programming.

Science - We will learn about light through investigations and practical activities.



- PSHE & Online safety - We will learn about health, wellbeing and creating a better world, alongside online safety.
- PE - We will develop skills in dodgeball indoors and take part in athletics outdoors.
- RE - We will explore ideas about Jesus' world and how we can help build a better world.
- Spanish - We will continue developing confidence with speaking and understanding.

Home Learning

- Read regularly (at least 3 times a week, ideally daily) with your child and encourage discussion about what they have read.
- Practise times tables and number facts using TTRS and Numbots.
- Encourage your child to talk about their learning and use new vocabulary.

Enrichment

- Professor McGinty will be visiting to share his knowledge about the Romans.
- Creative art, science and outdoor learning opportunities.
- Sports Day and transition activities.

Optional Activities

- Research a fact about the Romans and share it with the class.
- Go on a walk and identify different plants or sources of light.
- Create a simple computer game or set of instructions using events and actions.
