Here's what your child will be learning this half term:

Maths

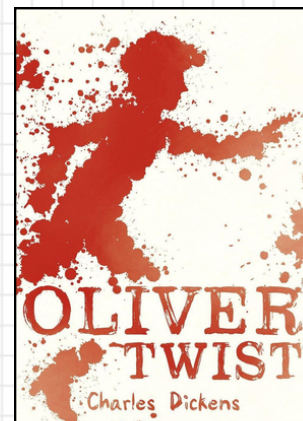
- We will revisit key areas of maths learning and continue developing confidence with arithmetic, reasoning and problem solving.
- We will practise applying maths skills accurately and efficiently across a range of contexts.
- We will continue preparing for the transition to secondary school maths.

Writing

- We will write poems that create vivid images and explore the impact of vocabulary choices.
- We will write first person narratives with a moral, focusing on themes, messages and character development.
- We will continue refining vocabulary choices and editing our writing for effect.

Reading

- We will read and explore extracts from *Oliver Twist*.
- We will learn how language, structure and context shape meaning within a text.
- We will develop skills in evaluating and critiquing texts, comparing ideas and justifying interpretations with precision.



Across the Curriculum

Computing - We will learn how to use spreadsheets to organise and present information.

Art - We will explore different artistic techniques and create our own creative artwork inspired by a range of ideas and stimuli.

Science - We will learn about evolution, adaptation and inheritance, including the work of Darwin and Wallace.

Design & Technology - We will explore electrical systems and textiles through practical design projects.

History - We will explore how conflict changed our local area during World War 2.



- PSHE & Online Safety - We will learn about puberty, drugs, peer influence, media influence and staying safe online.
- RE - We will explore what religious and non-religious world views teach about caring for the Earth.
- PE - We will develop skills in parkour indoors and take part in athletics outdoors.

Home Learning

- Encourage your child to read regularly and discuss themes and vocabulary within the text.
- Continue practising key maths skills and arithmetic fluency.
- Encourage your child to talk positively about the move to secondary school and growing independence.
- Talk with your child about personal safety, positive choices and staying safe online.

Enrichment

- Transition activities to support the move to secondary school.
- Opportunities for practical science, art and DT projects.
- Sports Day and outdoor learning activities.

Optional Activities

- Research an aspect of World War 2 linked to your local area.
- Create a poem using powerful imagery and ambitious vocabulary.
- Practise using spreadsheets to organise information at home.
