Summer Term 2

We're looking forward to a busy and exciting Summer Term in Reception.
Here's what your child will be learning this half term:

Maths

- We will develop a deep understanding of numbers to 10, including number bonds, doubles and counting beyond 20.
- We will compare quantities, explore patterns and investigate odd and even numbers.
- We will practise recognising numbers quickly and solving simple practical maths problems.

Writing

- We will write simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others.
- We will practise forming recognisable letters and spelling words using our phonics knowledge.
- We will continue developing pencil control, accuracy and care in our drawing and writing.

Reading

- We will enjoy sharing stories including *After the Fall*, *Lost and Found* and *Love*.
- We will learn that stories follow a clear structure and that vocabulary helps us understand what we read.
- We will practise reading simple sentences, retelling familiar stories and explaining our ideas clearly.



Across the Curriculum

We will learn how to keep ourselves healthy, safe and happy, including online.

We will use new vocabulary confidently in different situations and discussions.

We will explore similarities and differences between people, communities and environments.



We will continue exploring the natural world through Forest School and outdoor learning.

We will develop balance, coordination and movement through physical activities and games.

We will explore art, music and role play using a range of materials, tools and techniques.

Home Learning

- Read with your child regularly and talk about the stories you share together.
- Practise RWI sounds and blending to support reading fluency and confidence.
- Practise counting and number bonds.

Enrichment

- Forest School sessions and outdoor learning experiences.
- Music, singing and performance activities.
- Creative art, role play and collaborative learning opportunities.

Optional Activities

- Practise writing simple sentences, labels or captions at home.
- Go on a nature walk and talk about similarities and differences in the environment.
- Create pictures, models or role play stories using household materials.
