Here's what your child will be learning this half term:

Maths

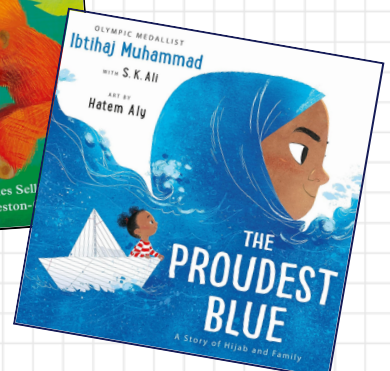
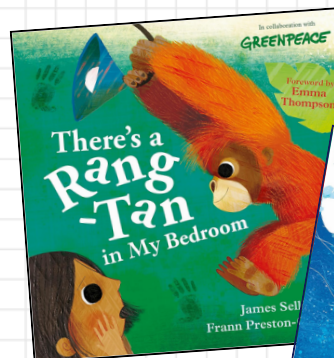
- We will learn about time, money, volume and capacity, mass and space.
- We will practise telling the time, recognising coins and comparing measurements.
- We will continue developing confidence with number fluency and problem solving.

Writing

- We will write recounts and setting descriptions using exciting vocabulary and descriptive language.
- We will continue developing sentence structure, punctuation and handwriting skills.
- We will practise editing and improving our writing independently.

Reading

- We will read and explore texts including *There's a Rang-Tan in My Bedroom*, *The Proudest Blue* and *The Hare and the Tortoise*.
- Children will develop comprehension, fluency and discussion skills through a range of stories and non-fiction texts.
- Continued daily phonics (RWI) to support reading confidence and fluency.



Across the Curriculum

Art - We will create 3D artwork using a range of materials and techniques.

Geography - We will explore the continents, oceans and countries of the United Kingdom.



Science - We will revisit learning about plants and animals including humans.

PE - We will develop skills in sending and receiving indoors and athletics outdoors.

History - We will learn about significant people including Neil Armstrong and Mae Jemison.



PSHE & Online Safety - We will learn about emotions, staying healthy, sun safety and keeping safe online.

RE - We will explore Christian beliefs about caring for others and the world.

Music - We will explore music through the At the Seaside unit.

Home Learning

- Read with your child at least 3-5 times a week and encourage the use of Fred Talk when needed.
- Practise RWI sounds regularly to build confidence and reading fluency.
- Support number fluency and key maths skills using everyday activities and Numbots.

Enrichment

- Dudley Zoo Trip linked to our Science learning.
- Sports Day and transition activities.
- Creative art, DT and outdoor learning opportunities.

Optional Activities

- Practise telling the time using clocks at home.
- Create a simple map showing the countries of the UK or the continents of the world.
- Write a short recount about a special day or visit.
