Uniform Policy

At Holywell, we expect children to:

- Take pride in their appearance
- Follow the uniform expectations outlined below

Standard Uniform in Nursery, Reception and KS1 (Y1 and Y2)

- Navy v-neck jumper or cardigan – logo optional
- White polo shirt – logo optional
- Grey tailored trousers or shorts
- Grey or navy skirt or pinafore
- Black, grey, navy or white socks or tights
- Plain black shoes (low-heeled or flat; no boots, trainers or open-toed sandals; laces only if children can tie them independently)
- Optional: Red and white summer gingham dress



Additional Accessories in Nursery, Reception and KS1 (Y1 and Y2)

- Navy book bag – logo optional
- Wellies – for Forest School
- Named, small plastic water bottle – filled with fresh water daily

Standard Uniform in KS2 (Y3, Y4, Y5 and Y6)

- Navy v-neck jumper or cardigan – logo optional
- White shirt – long or short sleeved
- Navy, red and white school tie – traditional, clip-on or elasticated
- Grey tailored trousers or shorts
- Grey or navy skirt or pinafore
- Black, grey, navy or white socks or tights
- Plain black shoes (low-heeled or flat; no boots, trainers or open-toed sandals; laces only if children can tie them independently)
- Optional Summer Uniform: Red and white summer gingham dress

- Optional Summer Uniform: White polo shirt

Additional Accessories in KS2 (Y3, Y4, Y5 and Y6)

- Named, small plastic water bottle – filled with fresh water daily

Whole School Active Uniform (PE days, Forest School days and other school days as notified)

- Navy plain hoodie or navy plain zip-up (sweatshirt material) – no logos
- Plain white, round-neck t-shirt – no logos
- Navy plain jogging bottoms, shorts or skorts (sweatshirt material) – no logos
- Black or white sports trainers – discreet logos only
- Black, grey or white socks

Whole School PE Safety

- All jewellery, including earrings and watches, must be removed for PE.
- Earrings should be removed before school on PE days if children cannot remove them independently. School staff are not permitted to remove earrings. Newly pierced ears may be covered with surgical tape provided from home.

Whole School Jewellery and Hairstyle Expectations

- One pair of plain gold or silver studs may be worn.
- One wristwatch (smart watches are not permitted).
- All hair long enough to be tied back must be tied up.
- Accessories (e.g. clips, hairbands, bobbles, scrunchies, hijabs) must be plain black, red or navy and of a reasonable size.

Whole School What Should Not Be Worn

To avoid confusion, the following items must not be worn:

- Trainers (except on Active Uniform days)
- Open-toed shoes or high heels
- Leggings or jeggings
- Jeans
- Make-up or nail polish

- Fake nails or nail extensions
- Visible temporary tattoos
- Necklaces and bracelets

Please Note:

- Ensure all uniform and accessories are **clearly labelled** with your child's name.
- If your child needs a reasonable adjustment (for example religious, medical or sensory needs), please speak to your child's class teacher.
