## Reception

### Summer Term 1

We're looking forward to a busy and exciting Summer Term in Reception.  
Here's what your child will be learning this half term:

#### Maths

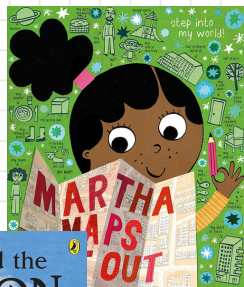
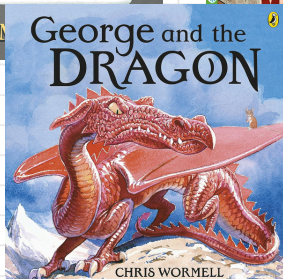
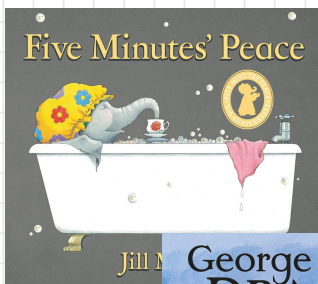
- We will explore numbers to 10, including number bonds and simple doubles.
- We will practise counting, including larger sets and counting beyond 20.
- We will explore shapes by building, rotating and combining them.
- We will create and continue repeating patterns (e.g. ABAB).

#### Writing

- We will practise writing simple sentences using our phonics knowledge.
- We will use capital letters and full stops correctly.
- We will learn to form lower case and capital letters neatly.
- We will begin to re-read our writing to check it makes sense.

#### Reading

- We will read and explore:
  - Five minutes peace
  - George and the dragon
  - Martha Maps it out
- Children will develop comprehension skills, vocabulary and discussion.
- Continued daily phonics (RWI) to support reading fluency.



## Across the Curriculum

We will develop listening, speaking and vocabulary skills through stories, discussions and using full sentences.

We will learn what maps are for and follow simple maps to find features around our school.

We will learn about what makes us special, understand our feelings, respect others and learn how to stay safe and healthy, including online.

We will develop fine motor control for writing and practise coordination and ball skills in PE.

We will explore art and design by drawing from observation, printing patterns and building models, sharing ideas and improving our work.

We will take part in music by listening carefully, singing songs and performing together, expressing our thoughts and feelings.



We will explore the natural world and talk about what we notice, including changes across the seasons.

## Home Learning

- Practise RWI sounds little and often to build confidence.
- Listen to your child read at least 3 times a week (ideally daily) and share their storybook together.
- Share bedtime stories.
- Use the 5-minute White Rose app to practise number bonds to 5 and 10.

## Enrichment

- Forest School sessions
- Taste Education activities
- STEM learning experiences
